2016 SUN CHASE VINEYARD PINOT NOIR

APPELLATION: Sonoma Coast

REGION: Sonoma County

Located on a southwest facing hillside between 900' and 1400' feet at the confluence of where the Petaluma Gap collides with Sonoma Mountain, Sun Chase is planted to Pinot Noir and Chardonnay and has quickly become recognized as one of the most highly sought-after vineyards in the Petaluma Gap. Its climate is heavily influenced by cool ocean breezes, and sits above the fog line which provides a nice balance of heat stress on the grapevines, allowing for slow and even maturation of the fruit.
