## **2016 TURNER VINEYARD PINOT NOIR**

**APPELLATION:** Sta. Rita Hills

**REGION:** Santa Barbara County

Planted in 2000, the Turner Vineyard is a 21- acre vineyard located in the northern part of the Sta. Rita Hills appellation, behind Melville and Babcock Vineyards, and just a stone's throw from Clos Pepe Vineyard. Ryan Carr planted the vineyard in 2000 with a very complex vineyard design. The vineyard was extremely fun to layout because of its great landscape; a dry, sandy river bed valley floor, steep North and South hillside slopes, and mesa plateau.
